

Road Closure at Ulpha Bridge 21st March for a period of up to 5 days.

Dear Residents.

Cumbria County Council have appointed a Contractor to undertake the parapet repair works to Ulpha Bridge. For the Contractor to undertake the works safely, the road will need to be closed to all vehicles. The official diversion route will be adequately signed to divert traffic as necessary (please see plan attached).

Please note, the road closure DOES NOT apply to any Emergency Services or Heavy Goods Vehicles (HGVs) due to the restrictions imposed on the diversion route. HGVs must proceed to the closure to be safely escorted through the works, which will allow them access to the Duddon Valley beyond Ulpha Bridge. We kindly ask that you inform any delivery services that you are expecting during the week commencing 21st March 2022. However, we would respectfully ask for your assistance in keeping HGV deliveries to a minimum, which will help in completing the works as quickly as possible so that the road can be fully reopened.

The highway will be reopened outside of working hours with signage being dismounted. Access through the road closure will be maintained for pedestrians and cyclists. The closure is scheduled for 21st March 2022 for a period of up to 5 days. We will contact you again if there is any need to delay the works due to unforeseen circumstances.

Cumbria County Council recognises this closure will cause some inconvenience, but these measures are necessary to ensure local residents and other highway users remain safe.

Our priority remains the safety of the public, contractors, and our staff as we work to maintain and ensure the standards of our roads.
