- Repair and improvement of local facilities and public areas
- Contributing towards the maintenance of local public buildings such as churches, village halls, etc.

Some other points to note:

- Grants are for groups and organisations that reside within the boundary of the Duddon Parish
- When your application has been processed and a decision made, we will contact you by letter or email
- You must spend the money on the items specified in your application
- If your application is granted, we may send you a 'Project Completion Form'. Please fill this in and return it along with copies of relevant receipts
- If your project costs are not as much as originally expected, please kindly return any unused funds
- And finally... it makes our job easier if you enclose as much relevant information as possible about your project/event

Timings and Deadlines

The Trustees meet Quarterly to consider applications made.

The closing date for applications for each Quarter being the last day of February, May, August, November each year

Decisions are taken in March, June, September and December.

If you are thinking of applying, please keep in mind these timeframes.
