Cllr Curwen advised that 4inch sewer pipes are no longer private and will be maintained by United Utilities. Cllr Curwen advised that on the A595 at Grizebeck the culvert had been jetted out. The jetter will be coming back to Broughton to clean drains. Cllr Curwen raised concern about 2 drains which had collapsed at the bottom of Princes Street and asked if the sign at Church Street had been put back up. Cllr Curwen advised that footpath edges from Bushgreen to Foxfield station are to be cut back.
